2. Describe the conditions which shock wont be occurred in the Burgers equation.
3. What is the geometrical explanation of the characteristic curves of the below equation?

$$a(x, t, u)u_x + b(x, t, u)u_t = c(x, t, u)$$

4. Assume the below equation.

$$u_t + u_x = u$$

$$\text{I.C. : } u(x, 1) = x - 2$$

  - II) Show the equation has an answer.
  - III) Find the characteristic curves.
  - IV) Solve the equation analytically.
5. Assume the Burgers equation ( $u_t + uu_x = 0$ ) with the following boundary conditions; Calculate the weak solution ( $t > 0$ ) and find the answer limitation when  $\epsilon$  goes to zero.

$$u(x, 0) = \begin{cases} 0 & x < 0 \\ x/\epsilon & 0 \leq x \leq \epsilon \\ 1 & x > \epsilon \end{cases}$$
